**You must register with your city's association. The Other Residents** section applies to residents from Les Cèdres, Pointe-des-Cascades, Ile-Cadieux and Vaudreuil-Sur-Le Lac as well as HMIP junior players only.

\*Other Residents: Les Cedres, Vaudreuil-sur-le-Lac, Ile-Cadieux and Pointe-des-Cascades and residents of Vaudreuil-Dorion without a citizen card, as well as Junior Players from HMIP. The Other Residents registration includes a \$50 administration fees. **Les Cèdres Residents: The \$100 subsidy will be reimbursed only when and if it is received.** The municipality of Les Cedres offers only 1 subsidy per child per year so, we may not receive it if it was allocated for another activity in the same year.

\*\* **Subsidy for players residing in Vaudreuil-Dorion (born after June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2008), if minor at the time of registration.** The subsidy will be reimbursed on the credit card on file, once received from the City and not credited at the time of registration. The City card must be valid.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR GIRLS:

**MIXED HOCKEY (with boys) WITH AHMVD** : *If your daughter wishes to play with AHMVD (mixed hockey) and has a profile, please contact us at [registraire@ahmvd.ca](mailto:registraire@ahmvd.ca) so that we may request a transfer for her registration with us. If your daughter has no profile (new member) and she wants to play mixed hockey, you must create her profile with AHMVD at the time of the registration.*

**GIRLS' HOCKEY (Storm du Sud-Ouest)**: *If your daughter wishes to play girls' hockey, please register with the Storm organization directly.* For the girls who played mixed hockey but wish now to play girls' hockey and do not have their profile linked to the Storm (no access to the Storm page), please contact the Storm at [registrairestorm@gmail.com](mailto:registrairestorm@gmail.com) so that a transfer may be requested to allow the registration. If your daughter has no profile (new member) and she wishes to play girls' hockey, her profile must be created with the STORM at the time of registration.

**Vaudreuil-Dorion residents**: Make sure that **the player's citizen card** is valid before proceeding to the registration and have it at hand as you have to enter the number, address on the card and the expiry date. If the card expires before the end of the year, make sure you renew it to benefit from the city subsidy.

**JUNIOR: HMIP members** must contact us at [registraire@ahmvd.ca](mailto:registraire@ahmvd.ca) so that we may request a transfer of their profile before the registration. **Do not create a new profile.**

## ONLINE REGISTRATION:

- **New this season: HQ has added a questionnaire for services with Phzio (players health and purchase of insurance).** *You may refuse this service but you must still answer the questionnaire.*

\*\*\* **Mandatory for new members only** : after having proceeded with the registration, please send two proofs of residency (copy of municipal or school taxes bill, bill of Hydro-Québec or bill of telephone – land line, television or residential internet) and a copy of the child's birth certificate to [registraire@ahmvd.ca](mailto:registraire@ahmvd.ca). If you fail to send said documents within 48 hours of your registration, we will not be able to confirm said registration and your child will not be allowed to participate to any activities on ice, as long as these documents are not submitted. You may also upload those documents in your child's HCR profile.

## **PAYMENT:**

Payment of registration fees is divided into three installments due as follows:

- 1) First payment equivalent to 50% of the total registration fee when registering on the Hockey Canada platform;
- 2) A second payment equivalent to 25% of the total registration fee as of September 1st, 2026;
- 3) A third payment equivalent to 25% of the total registration fee as of October 1st, 2026;

Installments will be automatically debited on the above dates on the credit card you have indicated in the file. You have to update the information in your spordle account whether for a new card or a renewed card. It is your responsibility to contact AHMVD for any changes to our credit card. For any refused or declined payment on the credit card, a fee of \$ 40 will be automatically charged. The only accepted method of payment for the registration fee is by credit card.

## REFUND POLICY:

### Withdrawal before September 1<sup>st</sup> (all levels)

In case of withdrawal of the player, only the withdrawal notified to the Registrar and to the Association (in writing to [registraire@ahmvd.ca](mailto:registraire@ahmvd.ca)) BEFORE September 1st, 2026 will be eligible for the full refund of the registration fees less a **\$50 to cover administration fees**. After this date, the refund will be established according to the following conditions:

### Withdrawal: All levels, except for M5-M7

- If the withdrawal occurs **between September 1<sup>st</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>** of the current year, please note that **a fee of \$250 is non-refundable** and will be retained at the time of the reimbursement. From the moment a player participates in any sporting activity offered by the AHMVD, membership fees for the federations of Hockey Québec, Hockey Canada and Hockey Lac St-Louis are no longer refundable.
- **As of October 1st 2026, no refund**, for any reason whatsoever, will be accepted, considered, calculated nor issued, with the exception of a withdrawal resulting from an injury, provided a letter from a doctor is submitted. *In this case, please refer to the injury clause below.*

### Withdrawal: Levels M5/M7

- If the withdrawal occurs **between September 1<sup>st</sup> and October 31<sup>st</sup>** of the current year, please note that **a fee of \$150 is non-refundable** and will be retained at the time of the reimbursement. From the moment a player participates in any sporting activity offered by the AHMVD, membership fees for the federations of Hockey Québec, Hockey Canada and Hockey Lac St-Louis are no longer refundable.
- **As of November 1st 2026, no refund**, for any reason whatsoever, will be accepted, considered, calculated nor issued, with the exception of a withdrawal resulting from an injury, provided a letter from a doctor is submitted. *In this case, please refer to the injury clause below.*

### Withdrawal for reason of an injury (all levels)

Only a withdrawal in case of injury may be subject to a partial reimbursement after the aforementioned dates relating to the levels, and this, **only until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026**. In order to obtain said partial reimbursement, a letter from a doctor will have to be duly submitted. In addition to the sum of \$250 that will be retained as mentioned above (\$150 for M5/M7 players), an administration fees of \$50 as well as a compensation for the ice cost will be kept, calculated at the pro rata of the sessions offered to the player (and not, according to the presence of the player at the sessions) will also be retained.

### Single letter Junior camp:

It is possible that a selection process be put in place if too many players are registered for the number of teams that will be confirmed in September. The players that will be released will get a reimbursement of their registration fees except for a **\$175 amount to cover AHMVD's expenses** (*this applies only to the players who won't be able to play in an AHMVD team and not to the players who would cancel their participation voluntarily*).

A withdrawal under the Reimbursement Policy is a voluntary or involuntary departure or enrollment of your child in school hockey that does not allow double carding.

## **PARENTAL CONTRIBUTION**

By registering my child, I understand that in addition to the registration fees mentioned above, I will have to pay a parental contribution ranging from approximately \$ 250 to \$ 400 to my child's team budget. This parental contribution is MANDATORY and is determined jointly by the coach and the team manager at the beginning of the season. I also understand that by registering my child above, I agree that he (she) will participate in tournaments, development sessions and additional practices and fundraising campaigns organized by my child's team, which activities are themselves part of the team budget. There is no parental contribution for players at the M5/M7 levels.

## **PLAYER POSITION AND TEAM NOT GARANTEED**

By registering my child, I understand that the position is required only to identify the number of available goalies at the beginning of the season. In no case the Association undertakes to have my child play at the position that I would have voluntarily identified with regards with the politics of the Association on the player's development.

It is also understood that the Association does not guarantee that my child will play to a given level nor in any given team nor with any given players, and this, even though, I request it in writing.

## **CODE OF CONDUCT and CODE OF ETHICS**

By agreeing to register your child for minor hockey activities in Vaudreuil-Dorion, you agree to sign and obtain the signature, if applicable, of the other parent and your child, of the code of conduct and the code of ethics which will be given to you at the beginning of the season. These codes of conduct and ethics are essential conditions for your child's presence on the ice. If you fail to sign and obtain the signature of the other parent and your child of each of the code of conduct and code of ethics, your child will not be able to participate in the hockey activities of the AHMVD, without you being eligible in any way for a refund of registration fees or compensation.

## **PLAYERS BORN IN 2022 (U5)**

Players born in 2022 must be always accompanied by an adult on the ice during hockey sessions. The adult that is accompanying the player needs to wear a helmet, hockey gloves and we strongly suggest that he/she also has a hockey stick.
